

THE PROCESS OF ALTERNATIVE DISPUTE RESOLUTION (ADR) IN CUSTOMARY LAND CONTEXTS



1 If possible, training and capacity building of ADR Committees and Clan Committees on customary land dispute resolution is conducted.



2 The ADR Committee Receives Cases and Analyzes together with the Clan/ Informal Structures.



7 If parties do not agree, they can appeal to the next hierarchy of ADR or formal courts of law.



6 If parties agree, they sign a consent agreement confirming the decision of the ADR Committee and/or Clan Committee



3 The ADRC and the Clan Committee Interprets the Family Land Rights and Lineage Tree to Understand Land Claims.



4 The ADRC and Clan Committee engage both parties in mediation, following principles of natural justice.



5 ADRCs and Clan Committees pass a decision on land Claims.
